WARNING! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT, WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS. PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU ARE SATISFIED YOU UNDERSTAND IT.

HEREBY AGREE with the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1 (hereinafter collectively called "the organiser") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the meeting") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS

2. I ACKNOWLEDGE that motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport and participating in the race meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows: -
- (a) That I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
 - (b) That my machinery or equipment may be damaged lost or destroyed;
 - (c) That other riders or competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
 - (d) That track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - (e) That organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
 - (f) That any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
 - (g) That there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
 - (h) That I have an obligation to myself and to others to act and compete safely and within the rules and regulations of competition.

4.2 Entry fee includes transponder hire.

4.5 Any fees for dishonoured cheques will be the responsibility of the entrant.

5. TRANSPONDERS

5.1 Electronic timing will be used for this event.

5.2 All transponders will be allocated by Revolution Timing to each competitor and it is their
Responsibility to fit the transponder to their machine

5.3 All competitors are liable for the return of their transponder.

6. PIT CONTROL

6.1 Only Riders and support crew are allowed in pits!!!

6.2 THE PITS SHALL BE CLOSED THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

6.3 Rider support vehicles are required to be parked outside the pit area.

6.4 No persons may wear open footwear in the pits.

6.5 Alcohol and/or persons affected by alcohol are not permitted in the pits.

6.6 Motorcycles shall not be ridden in the general public area.

6.7 There shall be **no smoking** in the pits.

6. NO DOGS ALLOWED AT TRACK / EVENT

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7. SCRUTINEERING

- 7.1 Machines entered in the competition must have successfully passed a machine examination prior to taking part in practice or racing
- 7.2 Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting.
- 7.3 The scrutineer can request at their discretion a check of any machine that has taken part in the event. Failure to comply with this rule will result in automatic exclusion from event. results
- 7.4 Bikes must be in safe working order - the following items will be checked on all bikes. If you or your bike fails any of these checks and the fault is not rectified before the sighting lap, you will not be permitted to start the race

8. AWARDS AND PRIZE MONEY

- 8.1 There is no prize money to be awarded. All classes will receive trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings.
- 8.2 All junior participants receive a participation medallion (except trophy recipients).
- 8.3 In order to be eligible for prizes or to be deemed as completed the event, all riders **must finish the event with the partner named on their entry form (JUNIORS EXCLUDED)**.
- 8.4 Riders are encouraged to continue riding the event, even if their partner has abandoned the race. However, in this case, **neither** rider will be eligible for prizes.

9. RIDERS BRIEFING

A riders briefing will be held prior to commencement of racing, which **all** competitors must attend. At completion all riders / guardians must sign off before racing commences
Riders who fail to attend the riders briefing will not be allowed to start

12. CODE OF CONDUCT

Any rider or person associated with a rider or entrant shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner in any dealings with any official of the meeting. A rider shall be responsible for his or her conduct and for that of any person with whom he or she is associated who abuses or threatens, verbally or physically, any official. Penalties which may be imposed for a breach include reprimand or warning, exclusion from the race meeting and/or report to Police.

13. SPECIAL NOTE AND WARNINGS

Warning to the Public - Motor racing is DANGEROUS, and spectators attending this track do so entirely at their own risk. It is a condition of admission that all persons having a connection with the organisation, and/or conduct of the meeting, including the owners of the land and the riders and owners of vehicles and passengers in the vehicles, are absolved from all liability arising out of accidents causing damage or personal injury to spectators or ticket holders.
